

## TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

### SPECIAL TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS FOR HONG KONG-ZHUHAI-MACAO BRIDGE (HONG KONG SECTION) HALF MARATHON 2024/25

Notice is hereby given that special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented on 4 January 2025 (Saturday) and 5 January 2025 (Sunday) to facilitate the holding of The HZMB (Hong Kong Section) Half Marathon 2024/25:

#### **I. TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS**

The following temporary traffic arrangements will be implemented on the section of HZMB HKLR between the HZMB Hong Kong Port (“HKP”) and the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (“HKSAR”) Boundary, subject to the actual finishing time of the event and re-opening of the roads for vehicle use:

III (Fig. 3)	From 2.00 pm to about 4.30 pm on 5 January 2025	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The left and middle lanes of the above section of HZMB HKLR (Hong Kong bound).</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Motorists heading for Hong Kong have to use the right lane of the above road section.</li></ul>
Others (Fig. 4)	From 9.00 pm on 4 January 2025 to about 3.00 pm on 5 January 2025	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>A section of outbound goods vehicles (GV) lanes at the HZMB HKP after the GV Clearance Plaza will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic.</li></ul>	

## II. PUBLIC TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS

To facilitate runners going to AsiaWorld-Expo, the services of the following public transport services will be temporarily adjusted on 5 January 2025 (Sunday):

### (A) Mass Transit Railway (MTR) Services

A total of 3 additional departures of Airport Express Line will be operated at 5.15 am, 5.25 am and 5.35 am from Hong Kong Station to AsiaWorld-Expo Station.

### (B) Franchised Bus Services

An additional bus stop outside AsiaWorld-Expo (“AWE”) will be observed by the following departures of the bus routes concerned:

(C) **HZMB Shuttle Bus, Cross-boundary Coaches and Cross-boundary Hire Car**

HZMB Shuttle Bus, cross-boundary coaches and cross-boundary hire cars will remain in operation during the event. The routings of these services will be diverted subject to the temporary traffic arrangements implemented on site.

**III. ATTENTION AND APPEAL**

Members of the public and tourists are advised to plan ahead their journeys as it is expected that the journey time on the HZMB HKLR (both directions) could be lengthened during the implementation of the above temporary traffic and transport arrangement. Appropriate traffic signs will be erected to guide motorists, and notices will be displayed by public transport operators to advise passengers of the temporary transport arrangements.

Depending on the prevailing circumstances, other ad-hoc traffic and public transport measures, including further closures of roads, traffic diversion, alterations and suspension of public transport services, may be implemented by the Police at short notice. Members of the public are advised to stay alert to the latest traffic news through the media.
